1. To decide whether they are in favour of voting the following amount to be levied by means of Owner's Rate for the current year:-

Parochial Property – Upkeep and Maintenance	£38900.00
Parochial Administration	£50125.00
Street Lighting	£19500.00
Provision of Christmas Lights	£7000.00

2. To authorise the Constables to apply to the Royal Court for permission to levy the sums above.
3. To decide that the said Owner's Rate, together with that approved at the meeting convened by the Rector and Churchwardens, shall be levied.
4. To decide whether they are in favour of voting the following amount to be levied upon property owners by means of Refuse Rate for the collection of household refuse for the current year.

Refuse Rate **£293020.92**

5. To authorize the factors for the Cadastre Categories to remain as they were for 2020. (Should you want to know the rates please contact the Constables Office on 238363).
6. To approve the Constables accounts for 2020 which have been duly audited
7. To elect three new members to the Cemetery Committee to replace Mrs B Herve, Mrs B Sparkes and Mrs J Meredith. Mrs Herve and Mrs Sparkes are eligible for re-election.
8. To elect Auditors to audit accounts for the Constables, the New Cemetery Committee, the Treasurer of the Parish School Committee and the Parochial Welfare Fund respectively for the year 2021
9. To take all such measures relating to the above as the Electors and Ratepayers may deem necessary.
