The Rector and Churchwardens of St Martin request the Ratepayers and Electors thereof to meet at the Parish Hall on Wednesday 27th April 2022 at 7.00 p.m. for the following purposes:-

1. To approve the Trésor Accounts which have been duly scrutinised, before the Very Reverend Timothy R. Barker, Dean of Guernsey, or his delegate.
2. To approve the Parochial Church Property Management Board Accounts for 2021 which have been duly audited (The accounts may be inspected at the Parish Office)
3. To elect two ratepayers to serve on the Parochial Church Property Management Board to replace Mr Dave Beausire and Mr Peter Dorey, both of whom are eligible for re-election.
4. To hear the Rector nominate his Warden to replace Mrs Laura Stockwell whose term of office has expired and who is eligible for re-nomination.
5. To receive the annual report of the Parochial Church Property Management Board relating to the insurance of the parochial church property. Insurance by Ecclesiastical Insurance PLC.
6. To decide whether, on the recommendation of the Parochial Church Property Management Board they are of the opinion to levy the following sums by means of Owner's Rate:

a) Ordinary repairs to the Parish Church.	£2500.00
b) Extraordinary repairs to the Parish Church for which outline estimates have been obtained, namely, repairs to the window to the East elevation in the vestry including internal and external scaffolding, repointing, installation of water repellent, removal and replacement of plaster, redecoration and repairs to wooden paneling.	£16450.00
c) Insurance of Parish Church and Churchyard	£2000.00
d) Upkeep of church yard	£6700.00
e) Upkeep of Parish Church clock and bells	£400.00
f) Cost of publishing parochial notices	£1000.00
TOTAL	£29050.00

6. To request the Constables to apply to the Royal Court for a Remède to levy the sums voted under paragraph 5 above.
